Open all year round. Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve open from 6 am to 12 pm, on New Year's Day from 1 pm. Closed on Good Friday and Christmas Day. Sunday opening hours apply on all other public holidays.		
Children up to and including 9 years of age are only admitted with an adult accompanying person. Minors are only allowed to enter the sauna with a parent or guardian.

Children up to and including 6 years have free admission to the swimming pool.
Children/young people and their accompanying adults can pay for admission with the Stuttgart FamilyCard . "Schwabenkarte" and vouchers cannot be purchased with it.
Accompanying persons of severely disabled persons receive free admission if a "B" or "H" is entered in the severely disabled person's ID card.
Price reduction of 1.00 Euro on the single admission ticket for holders of the Stuttgart Bonuscard.
When leaving the pool, the admission ticket loses its validity .
Electronic cards for multiple use, "Schwabenkarte" and vouchers are valid for 4 years from purchase .
